## REMARKS.

Tues-day

The barometer has continued to rise since yesterday except in Scotland, Ireland and the west of France, where it has fallen slightly, chiefly during the night. Pressure is now highest at Helder, and exceeds that at Valencia and Thirso by about 0.37 in.

Temperature has risen a little at nearly all stations, chiefly at Dravim, where it is now highest.

Westerly airs and calms are prevalent in the more eastern districts, while on our western coasts the wind is moderate from the S<sup>W</sup>. At Rochefort it has shifted to N.

Ruin has fallen in the south of Ireland, and a little at some eastern stations also; but in Great Britain the sky has become much clearer than of late. The sea is moderate in the Bay of Biscay, and at Pelley, but calm generally.

The barometer has fallen a little at most stations. Winds have "backed" somewhat on the East coast, but ~~the~~ continue light. — Rain has ceased in Ireland.

## REMARKS.

Wednes-day

The changes in barometrical pressure during the past have been slight and irregular, but readings are rather lower this morning than they were yesterday, except in the south of Ireland and at Yarmouth. Pressure is now 0.34 in. higher at Yarmouth than at Thurso.

Temperature has risen on the French and English coasts, but is scarcely changed in Ireland and Scotland.

A light to moderate N.W. wind is now reported on our northern coasts, but elsewhere S<sup>W</sup> and S.E.<sup>W</sup> winds, with calms, are chiefly prevalent.

Rain and fog have continued at the Irish stations. On our other coasts the weather continues fine, except at Ardrossan, where it has commenced raining. The sea is calm generally.

2. P.M. The barometer has fallen very slightly except at Scilly and Rochefort. Temperature has risen considerably in London, and is high at our eastern stations. Winds are very light and W<sup>by</sup>N.

## REMARKS.

Fri - day

The barometer has now commenced rising on all but our eastern coasts, the depression noticed yesterday having travelled to the eastward. The rise at Valencia since yesterday morning amounts to a quarter of an inch. The lowest reading reported is still at Thurso, and is 0.60 in. lower than that at Valencia and Rochefort.

Temperature has decreased except at the extreme southwestern stations, where there is no change.

The wind has now veered to W. or NW. on all our coasts, and is fresh at some northern stations. At Androssan it blew with force 8 for a short time early this morning. At Helder the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> wind continues, while in Norway a SE current prevails.

The weather has been rather showery in several places, with lightning at Dover. The sky is cloudy generally. The sea is moderate to calm.

2 P. M. The barometer continues to rise on all coasts, chiefly in the W. and N. The wind is moderate from WNW, with cloudy weather.

## REMARKS.

Satur-day

The barometer has continued to rise on all our coasts since yesterday, though the change has now been greatest in the north and east. Pressure is still highest in the south, the reading at L' Orient exceeding that at Thurso by 0.51 in.

Temperature has risen a little in the west, and fallen in the extreme north, but is hardly changed elsewhere.

The winds are light to moderate generally. At the eastern stations and in the west of France they remain NW<sup>ly</sup>, but in the west and north of the British Islands they have "backed" to SW again.

Cloudy weather has been general, with showers in several places. The sky is now clear in the S.E., cloudy elsewhere, with fog at Valencia, rain at Thurso, Ardrossan and Holyhead. The sea is moderate at Leilly and Ardrossan, nearly calm generally.

2. P.M. The barometer has again risen except at Thurso, where it has fallen somewhat, with rain. Light to moderate SW and W winds are general.

## REMARKS.

Tues-day

Barometrical pressure has fallen slightly at most stations, but risen at Valencia and in Norway. It is now rising generally in the west, and is very uniform.

Temperature has risen at nearly all stations, and the weather is warm over our Islands - amounting to  $70^{\circ}$  at some stations.

A light E<sup>ly</sup> breeze now prevails at all the southern stations, drawing round to S, in Ireland and Scotland.

The weather continues fine generally. The sky is rather cloudy in the west and north-west, but clear in most places with fog on the east coast. The sea is calm.

Note. It will be observed that a reporting station has now been established at Tumburgh Head, Shetland Isles, whence telegrams will be received daily, for the future.

## REMARKS.

Mon-day

Since Saturday the barometer has fallen slightly in all the southern districts and in Norway, but remained almost steady in Scotland and the north of Ireland. Readings though still very uniform are lowest in the south, that at L'Orient being 0.31 in. lower than that at Greencastle,

Temperature has now fallen considerably at the northern stations, but risen slightly in Wales and the southwest of England. It is still above  $70^{\circ}$  at most of our southern stations.

The wind is circulating round the high pressure in the north-west, being NW  $\frac{1}{2}$  in Scotland, NE  $\frac{1}{2}$  on our east coast, and E  $\frac{1}{2}$  in the Channel. It is light to moderate generally, but fresh at Helder.

Night aurora was seen at Raim on Saturday night. Thunder  
 and lightning occurred along our south coast, and at Biarritz, and  
 a little rain has fallen in some parts of the country. The weather is  
 otherwise fine. The sea is moderate at Yarmouth, calm elsewhere.

# REMARKS.

Wednes-day

Lightning was again seen in the south and southeast of England last night, and a heavy thunderstorm has occurred at Biarritz. The weather is now fine generally, but very cloudy in places. The sea is calm except at Christiansund.

Rain has been general, heavy in the south, and still continuing at several stations. The sky is overcast. The sea is very rough at Feilly, rough at Valencia and Forest, moderate at most stations.

## REMARKS.

Satur-day

Yesterday's barometrical depression appears to have crossed the British Isles and to be now over the North Sea. The recovery of pressure on our coasts has been very brisk, while in Norway the barometer has fallen rather fast. The lowest reading reported is at Oslo and is 0.47 in. lower than that at Scilly.

Temperature has fallen at nearly all stations.

The gale of yesterday died down apparently without extending. The wind has since shifted to NW in the British Islands generally, and is moderate, while in Norway it is SE<sup>ly</sup>. A tendency to "back" again is however noticed in the west of Ireland.

Rain has been general except in the extreme southwest. In the north it has been very heavy, and continues in the Shetlands and Norway. The sea is moderate to calm.

Burns were lowered again last evening.

# REMARKS.

Mon - day

Yesterday morning the barometer had risen considerably at the north and northeast stations, but had commenced falling again in the west and northwest. During the day this fall continued and extended to our north and east coasts, but has since been succeeded by a recovery in the west. The highest reading is at L' Orient, and exceeds that at Wick by 0.49 in: and that at Kudesnaes by 0.63 in.

Temperature has changed very variably. Yarmouth is now 14° warmer than Wick.

It blew a fresh gale from S. and SE. in the Irish Channel yesterday, but the wind has now subsided and veered to NW. At our other stations moderate W and SW breezes are general, and a SE gale in Norway.

Rain has been general - very heavy in Scotland. Aurora was seen in London and Cork last night. The sky is very cloudy except in the SW. The sea is high at Kudesnaes, moderate to calm generally.

# REMARKS.

Tues - day

The barometer continued to rise on all our coasts till last evening, while the depression noticed yesterday passed on towards Christiansund. During the night however a fresh fall has set in on the Irish and Scotch coasts. Pressure is now highest at Holyhead, and exceeds by 0.15 in. that at Valence and Green castle, and by 0.35 in. that at Lumburgh Head.

Temperature has fallen in England and Norway, but risen slightly at the Irish and Scotch stations.

The wind over the British Isles circulates round the high pressure at Holyhead, and is light. In Norway however it blows a gale from NW.

A little rain has fallen in the north. Aurora was seen in Scotland, Ireland and London last night. The sky is moderately free from cloud, except in the extreme north, but haze prevails in some places. The sea is high on the Norwegian coast, calm around the British Isles.

# REMARKS.

Wednesday

The fall of the barometer has continued at nearly all stations especially in the north of Scotland, where it amounts to nearly half an inch since yesterday morning. At Biarritz, however, a slight rise has set in; and at Christiansund a recovery has taken place from the depression noticed there yesterday. The lowest reading is now at Thurso, being 0.59 in lower than that at Rochefort.

Temperature has risen in the north and northwest of the British Isles, but is hardly changed elsewhere. Lumburgh Head is 12° colder than Dover.

The NW. gale in Norway has subsided, and the wind "backed" to SE. again. In the north of Scotland it has "backed" to S., but is SW  $\frac{1}{2}$  at our other stations, and NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  in the Bay of Biscay, - but light generally.

A little rain has fallen at the N<sup>W</sup> and W<sup>W</sup> stations. The sky has become very cloudy in most places. The sea is going down on the Norwegian coast, and is moderate to calm generally.

## REMARKS.

Thurs. day

Barometrical pressure was not much changed over the British Isles last evening, but during the night a rapid decrease has taken place at our western stations and in Norway, extending in less degree to our other coasts also. The highest reading at present reported is at Rochefort exceeding by about 0.70 inch those at Valencia, Lumburgh Head, and Christiansund.

Temperature is little changed beyond a rise of a few degrees in Norway.

The SW  $\frac{1}{2}$  wind continues over the British Islands, but during the night it has freshened considerably at our southwestern stations, and blows a gale at Rock's Point this morning. Elsewhere it is light or moderate.

Heavy rain has fallen in the south of Ireland, and less at our other western stations. The weather is overcast and seems very unsettled. The sea has risen and is rough at our southwest stations, but calm elsewhere.

On our own coasts the wind after falling light generally, has now freshened from W and NW in the north-western districts, and blows a moderate gale at Greencastle, Ardrossan, and Leith this morning. Elsewhere light to moderate NW breezes prevail.

A little rain has fallen in the N and W; but the sky has cleared considerably. The sea is rough at Ardrossan, moderate to calm generally.

Since Saturday the barometer has continued to rise at all but our southwestern and the French stations, where a decrease has taken place in pressure during the past 24 hours. Temperature has risen a little except at some of the western stations, where it has fallen slightly.

A little rain has fallen in the north. The sky is however more clear in most parts, with fog or haze in a few places. The sea is calm.

## REMARKS.

Thurs-day

During the past day the barometer has continued to fall generally except at Ikudisnaes and Christiansund, where it has risen a little. The decrease has been greatest at our southwestern stations, amounting to 0.44 in. at Valentia; where the reading now is 0.40 in. lower than that at Scarborough.

Temperature has risen; except at a few places where it has fallen locally, and thick fog is prevalent.

The wind is blowing round the region of greatest pressure, at Scarborough; being light from E in the south, rather fresh from SE in the west, light from S. in Scotland, and from NW at Skudesnæs.

The weather is fine and bright generally, but foggy in a few places. The sea is rather rough at Valencia and Scilly, moderate to calm elsewhere.

## REMARKS.

Wednes-day

During the past day the barometer has continued to fall except at Christiansund and the southwest of France, where it has risen. The change has been greatest on the east coast of England, and least at the southwestern stations. The highest reading is at Oxo but is only 0.36 in. higher than that at Valentia.

Temperature has changed very irregularly. In Norway, and at several of the Scotch, and French southwestern stations it has fallen with foggy weather, while in England and the north of France it has risen in most places.

The wind is very light generally; blowing round gradually from E in the Channel, through SE on our west coasts - to S in the north of Scotland, and SW in the south of Norway. In the Bay of Biscay variable airs are reported.

The sky has become overcast in the south of Ireland. Elsewhere there is not much cloud, but a good deal of fog is reported in some districts. The sea is calm on the whole.
