Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1800 UTC to 1800 UTC

General Situation

Low west of Scotland, moving slowly north, associated frontal trough moving east or southeast over the United Kingdom. High pressure building from the southwest.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly veering westerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6, backing southwesterly 3 or 4 later.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north and west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly backing southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later in west.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in rain.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

in far west.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

Occasional rain, mainly fair later but risk fog patches.

Slight or moderate.

Variable becoming southerly 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in southwest.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:
Southerly, veering northwesterly for a time, 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4.
Rain clearing then mainly fair.
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.
Slight or moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable or southerly 3 or 4.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.
Mainly slight.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
Southerly, veering westerly for a time, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing 3 or 4.
Rain then showers.
Moderate or poor, becoming good.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southerly 3 or 4, increasing 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in far north.
Mainly fair, occasional rain later in north.
Moderate or good.
Slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
West or southwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 or 4.
Rain or showers, mainly fair later.
Mainly good.
Moderate becoming slight.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 3 or 4.
Fair.
Good.
Slight or moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

Westerly backing southerly 5 or 6, decreasing 4.
Showers then mainly fair.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel

Rain or showers then mainly fair.

Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Moderate or rough, decreasing slight or moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly, veering northwesterly for a time, 5 to 7, decreasing 4 later.

Rain or showers then mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in rain.

Moderate or rough.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 4, increasing 5 to 7.

Occasional rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later in north.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides

24 hour forecast:

Southerly, veering westerly for a time, 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Rain or showers then mainly fair.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Moderate or rough.

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8.
