General Situation

A deep low is slow moving to the west of Ireland. This will be the dominant weather feature for the next few days bringing frontal systems to all areas of the United Kingdom.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel - (SWW)

Southerly or southeasterly 5 to 7, but mainly 4 or 5 in far northeast.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Rain then showers, fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Southerly or southeasterly 5 or 6, but mainly 4 or 5 in northeast.

Moderate or rough decreasing slight or moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

Southeasterly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5 in east.
Moderate, occasionally rough in west.
Occasional rain, fair later.
