General Situation

High pressure will continue to build to the north of the United Kingdom during the next 48 hours, bringing a northerly or northeasterly flow to many areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 3 or 4, veering easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in northwest.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate at times.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly, veering southwesterly later in northwest, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in northwest.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time towards Rattray Head.

Fair.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming north or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fog patches, becoming mainly fair.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough for a time.

Fair.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth becoming slight.

Fog patches, fair later.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 4 or 5, veering northeast 3 or 4 later.

Slight becoming moderate, occasionally rough.

Fair.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks, fair later.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming mainly good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast, backing northwest later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, then becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight becoming moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in south.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks in north, fog patches in south.

Moderate to very poor, occasionally good in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in south, becoming variable 3 or less later in south.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Fog patches, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast, becoming variable at times, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate offshore.

Mainly fair then showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 for a time.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate offshore.

Mainly fair.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

East or northeast, becoming variable at times, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Fair then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast, becoming variable at times, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

North or northeast 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Mainly fair.
Good, occasionally poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North or northeast, becoming variable at times, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Mainly fair.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:
Variable becoming easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 later in north.
Smooth or slight.
Mainly fair.
Good, occasionally poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, becoming variable 3 or 4 in south.
Smooth or slight.
Fair.

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times, becoming easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5 later.
Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, becoming variable 3 or 4 at times in south.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northerly or northeasterly, veering southeasterly later in south, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.
Smooth in shelter, otherwise slight, occasionally moderate.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or 4 in south, otherwise easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 until later in north.
Smooth in shelter, otherwise slight, occasionally moderate.
Fair.
Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northerly or northeasterly, veering southeasterly later in south, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.
Slight or moderate.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or 4 in south, otherwise easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 until later in north.
Slight or moderate.
Fair.
Good.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
A ridge of high pressure will cover Shetland and surrounding waters.

Slight or moderate

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 04 Jun until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 05 Jun:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east
Moderate, becoming rough in east
Fair
Good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to east 4 to 5, locally variable 2 to 3 in the west early morning, locally 6 at times from midday.

Slight to moderate.

Isolated thundery showers mainly in the south gradually spreading north mist or fog patches in the north of the area this morning and early afternoon, and perhaps near the normandy coast Tuesday morning.

Good, locally moderate to poor in showers and poor or very poor in mist or fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 to 5, locally 6 at times.

Slight to moderate, perhaps locally rather rough, with a low swell.

Isolated thundery showers risk of mist or fog patches at times, mainly in the south of the area.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor, perhaps very poor.
