### Forecast for Friday 01 Jul 2022

**Weather:** The morning will be mostly dry with clear or sunny periods but with showers in the far northeast of the area towards Strathdon. Often cloudy in the afternoon with scattered showers, some of these heavy with a risk of a thunderstorm. Showers will only slowly die out from the west in the evening.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m:** 80%

**Low cloud and visibility:** Generally very good outside of showers. Cloud largely above summits, but lowering to 900 metres at times especially in or around showers.

## Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Drenching conditions possible in afternoon showers with a risk of lightning.

## Forecast for Saturday 02 Jul 2022

**Weather:** Cloudy and unsettled with showers or some longer spells of rain throughout the day. The southwest of the area may become drier as the afternoon progresses.

**Maximum wind:** Westerly 20 to 30 mph on the summits

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m:** 60%

**Low cloud and visibility:** Poor in areas of cloud down to 600 metres at first in the south of the region, otherwise cloud mostly at 900 metres or above

**Temperature:** **Glens:** Plus 7 rising to 16 Celsius  
**At 800m:** Plus 8 Celsius  
**Freezing level:** Above summits
