General Situation

High pressure will remain centred close to the southwest of the British Isles with low pressure near Iceland. A westerly or southwesterly flow will cover the United Kingdom with winds strong at times in the north.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in east, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate in east, rough or very rough in north.

Occasional rain, mainly in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in north.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Anticyclone over southern UK will maintain a fresh westerly airflow over Shetland waters with troughs giving unsettled weather conditions.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Westerly 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time in south.
Moderate or rough, but very rough in west.

Rain at times.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Monday 02 Sep until 0000 UTC on Tuesday 03 Sep:

West veering northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time, backing west 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight over sheltered eastern waters.

Mainly fair.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 2 to 4, soon decreasing 1 to 3, locally 4 in the north late afternoon.
