General Situation

A large area of high pressure covers the United Kingdom. A deep area of low pressure tracking to the south of Iceland will introduce stronger winds to the north.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

General Situation
Deep low around Iceland moving northeast through the Norwegian Sea on Wednesday with associated weather front pushing east through Shetland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southeasterly severe gale force 9 at time of issue.

South or southwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in north and west.
Rough or very rough, but moderate in sheltered eastern waters.
