General Situation

The United Kingdom will continue to be covered by a slack pressure pattern during the next 24 hours. Sea fog will continue to affect some coastal areas and there will be some thundery showers in northern and eastern parts.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 at first.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers for a time, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming north later, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks until later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, becoming moderate or good later.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks and showers developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming north or northeast, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 at first, then becoming north or northwest later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks and thundery showers developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 2 or 3, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers at first, fog banks.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 at first.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks developing, thundery showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming north or northwest 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers at first, fog banks.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks developing, thundery showers until later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming northerly or northeasterly later, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 2 at times later.

Slight, occasionally smooth later.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in east, then becoming variable 1 or 2 later.

Slight, occasionally smooth later.

Fog patches then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming northeast later, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing south, then east or northeast later, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later near the Isles of Scilly.

Fog patches at first in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west, becoming variable 2 at times in east.

Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in west.

Fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Slight.

Fair.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming north or northeast, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest becoming variable, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first, thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable, but becoming mainly southerly in east, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers for a time, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, but southerly or southeasterly at first in east, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southerly 3 or 4 for a time.
Smooth or slight.
Fog patches, thundery showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.
Smooth or slight.
Fog patches, thundery showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

Thundery showers for a time in east, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first.
Slight.
Thundery showers for a time at first in east, fog patches at first.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less becoming north or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Slight.
Fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first.
Slight or moderate.
Fog patches at first.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
A slack flow covers Shetland and surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

Variable 3 or less.
Slight.

Mist and fog, occasionally fair.
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Saturday 02 Jun until 0600 UTC on Sunday 03 Jun:

Variable mainly northwest, 3 or less, occasionally 4 later.

Slight.

Mist and fog, occasionally fair.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Southwest or variable 1 to 3, occasionally north to northeast 4 this afternoon, becoming northeast to east 2 to 4 this evening.

Smooth or slight.

Risk of mist and fog patches until noon.

Good, perhaps locally poor or very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast to east 3 to 4, increasing 4 to 5 in the afternoon, decreasing 3 to 4 overnight.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in the southwest in the afternoon, with a low swell.

Risk of mist or fog patches at first in the morning.

Good, perhaps locally moderate to poor.

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
