General Situation

Showers will affect western and northern areas during the weekend, although most southern and southeastern parts should remain fair until later. Winds will be mostly gentle throughout.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less becoming easterly 2 to 4, occasionally 5 in northwest.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair, perhaps misty for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 3 to 5, occasionally 6 later west of Orkney.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Showers, thundery later, misty at times.

Good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southeast 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair at first, but risk of mist overnight, then showers later in south, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 2 or 3, becoming cyclonic 2 to 4.

Slight.

Thundery showers, mist.

Good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southeast 2 to 4.

Slight.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering southwest 3 to 5, occasionally 6 for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate for a time.

Showers, thundery later.

Good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southeast 2 to 4.

Slight, occasionally smooth in south.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering southwest 3 to 5, occasionally 6 for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate for a time in north.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southeasterly 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly veering southwesterly 3 to 5.

Slight, occasionally smooth.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly southeasterly 2 to 4, occasionally 5 later in west.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly veering southwesterly 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, veering southwest later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight, occasionally smooth.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, mainly in west, but mainly fair elsewhere.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers or rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight.

Showers, but fair for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.
Showers or rain.
Good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly south 2 to 4.
Smooth or slight.
Showers, perhaps thundery later.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 2 to 4, veering southwest 3 to 5, occasionally 6 for a time.
Slight or moderate.
Showers, perhaps thundery later in north.
Good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly south or southeast 2 to 4.
Smooth or slight.
Showers, perhaps thundery later.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 2 to 4, veering southwest 3 to 5, occasionally 6 for a time, becoming cyclonic in north.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later in northwest.
Showers, perhaps thundery later.
Good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly south or southeast 2 to 4.
Smooth or slight.
Showers, perhaps thundery.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 2 to 4, veering southwest 3 to 5, occasionally 6 for a time.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.
Showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 2 to 4, occasionally 5 later in east.
Smooth or slight.
Showers, perhaps thundery, but fair at first in north.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering southwest, but cyclonic for a time, 3 to 5, decreasing 2 for a time.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later except in far north.
Showers, perhaps thundery.
Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 2 to 4, occasionally 5 later in North Channel.
Smooth or slight.
Fair then showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly veering southwesterly, but cyclonic for a time, 3 to 5, decreasing 2 for a time.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later in North Channel.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southeasterly 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later near Tiree.

Fair then showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 3 to 5, becoming cyclonic 3 or less.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first near Tiree.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming east or southeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, mainly later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

Variable 4 or less, becoming east or southeast 3 to 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate to the west of the Outer Hebrides.

Showers, mainly later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 3 to 5, becoming cyclonic 3 or less in south.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A weak ridge of high pressure will persist across Shetland Waters over the next 24 hours.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 3 to 4, locally variable 1 to 2 at first, backing east to northeast 3 to 5 by late afternoon, then veering westerly 3 to 4, locally 5, overnight.

Smooth, occasionally slight.

Isolated showers mist with local fog patches, mainly Sunday morning.

Good, occasionally moderate, locally poor or very poor overnight.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 3 to 4, locally variable or northerly 1 to 2 in the south of the area, becoming southwest to south 4 to 5 overnight, perhaps locally 6 mid-channel.

Slight or smooth, becoming slight to moderate overnight, with a low swell.

Mist and local fog patches at first soon clearing east occasional light rain spreading eastwards from midnight.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor, locally very poor at first.

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
