General Situation

An area of high pressure just to the north of Scotland and low pressure in southern biscoy will bring an easterly or northeasterly flow to much of the British Isles. Winds will be strong in many southern areas.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to east 3 to 5 in the southeast of the area, and 5 to 7 in the northwest of the area, perhaps occasionally gale 8 mid-channel until midday, becoming easterly or variable 2 to 4 guernsey southeastwards later.

Slight to moderate in the southeast of the area, rather rough to rough in the northwest.

Rain or showers, locally heavy, with sleet at times risk of mist patches near french coasts until mid-morning and again later.

Good, occasionally moderate, locally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or variable 2 to 4 on the southeast of the area, northeasterly 4 to 6 in the northwest of the area, occasionally 7 mid-channel until midday, becoming generally northeast 2 to 4 overnight.

Smooth to slight in the southeast of the area, moderate to rather rough in the northwest, becoming generally smooth or slight by midday, occasionally moderate mid-channel.

Rain or showers, locally heavy, with sleet at times risk of mist patches near french coasts until mid-morning.

Good, occasionally moderate, locally poor.

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
