Forecast for Saturday 10 Jul 2021

Weather: Many west coast ranges will be dry, some patchy low cloud in the morning but some bright spells in the afternoon. Elsewhere extensive low cloud with some patchy rain in the morning. Low cloud gradually clearing away in the morning to leave some sunny spells for the afternoon, along with a few slow moving heavy showers inland. Rather warm and humid in afternoon sunshine.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 60%

Visibility: Poor in extensive low cloud between 300 and 500 metres in the morning, this patchy along the west coast. This clearing in the afternoon with visibility becoming mainly good. Cloud lowering to 850 metres in any afternoon downpours.

Forecast for Sunday 11 Jul 2021

Weather: Overnight low cloud across the east of the area soon clearing in the morning. Then a bright and warm day, some slow moving heavy showers breaking out in the afternoon.

Maximum wind: Southerly 10 mph

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 90%

Visibility: Some low cloud down to 400 metres at first, otherwise summits mostly clear of cloud. Cloud lowering onto the higher summits in heavier showers.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 11 rising to 21 Celsius
At 800m: Plus 12 Celsius
Freezing level: Above summits
