Forecast for Friday 06 May 2022

Weather: Cloudy with rain at first, clearing south across most areas by mid morning. Then mainly dry with sunny intervals, though thicker cloud may bring a few showers for a time in the late afternoon and evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: Only 10% at first rising to 80% by afternoon. Falling 60% in north in evening.

Low cloud and visibility: At first, extensive cloud at 600-900m the lower bases in the west, with moderate occasionally poor visibility in rain, then cloud breaking up towards late morning with good visibility, away from any remaining patchy summit cloud. Some increase in cloud and poor visibility towards evening.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Some slight uncertainty in showers later.

Forecast for Saturday 07 May 2022

Weather: Mainly dry with variable cloud and some sunny intervals. Perhaps one or two showers.

Maximum wind: Variable 5-10mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: More than 80%.

Low cloud and visibility: Good visibility with cloud remaining above the tops.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 4 Celsius at dawn rising to Plus 16 in the afternoon.

At 800m: Plus 4 rising to Plus 7 Celsius.

Freezing level: Above the summits.
