Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 UTC to 1200 UTC

General Situation

Ridge of high pressure over northern United Kingdom. Weakening cold front moving south across northern and eastern Scotland and into eastern England later.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest veering north 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Occasional rain at first, then mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Slight or moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3 becoming north or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Occasional rain for a time, then fair.

Moderate or poor becoming mainly good.

Smooth or slight increasing moderate.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 2 or 3 increasing 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Fog patches at first, occasional rain for a time, then fair.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor at first, becoming mainly good.

Slight increasing moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Occasionally misty, patchy rain for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Mainly fair, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Slight or moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Slight or moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6.
Fair.
Good, occasionally moderate.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel
24 hour forecast:
Northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6.
Fair.
Good, occasionally moderate.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near Lands End.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:
Northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south at first, decreasing 3 in north later.
Fair.
Good.
Slight or moderate.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
Mainly north or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5.
Fair.
Good.
Smooth or slight.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
Northeast 4 or 5 soon decreasing 3 or 4.
Fair.
Good.
Moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
Northerly 2 or 3, occasionally 4.
Fair.
Moderate or good.
Slight, occasionally moderate in north.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel
24 hour forecast:
Variable becoming northeasterly 2 or 3, occasionally 4.
Fair.
Good, occasionally moderate.
Smooth or slight.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Mainly northerly 2 or 3, increasing 4 or 5 for a time.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.
Slight, occasionally moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides
24 hour forecast:
Variable 2 or 3 becoming north or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5.
Occasional rain then mainly fair.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.
Smooth or slight becoming slight or moderate.

Shetland Isles

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Moderate, occasionally rough for a time.

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
