### Forecast for Wednesday 08 Jun 2022

**Weather:** Dry through the early hours with some clear spells in the west, but occasional low cloud could cover some of the higher peaks to the east of the A9. Some morning brightness in the northwest, but otherwise mainly cloudy with showery rain spreading north through the afternoon. Much of the low cloud staying confined to eastern and southeastern hills by day, but slowly affecting most hills by late-evening.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m:** 70% northwest, 30% southeast. Becoming more widely 20% by late-evening.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Occasional low cloud around 400-600 m overnight and early morning, mainly south and east. Some lingering around eastern and southeastern peaks during the day but mostly lifting and breaking. Cloud associated with showery rain generally above summits but locally down to 700-900 m. Very poor visibility within cloud otherwise good occasionally moderate in rain or showers.

**Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View**

**Forecast for Thursday 09 Jun 2022**

**Weather:** Overnight low cloud, mainly in the east, lifting and breaking through the morning. Then dry and bright for a time before thickening cloud brings light rain and strengthening south or southwest winds into the southwest later.

**Maximum wind:** Southerly or southwesterly mean 25 mph gusting 35-40 mph on the Cairngorm Plateau from late-afternoon. Winds mostly much lighter earlier in the day.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m:** 40% overnight and early morning, increasing 90% for a time, then 60% from late-evening.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Occasional overnight/early morning cloud down to 400 m, otherwise mainly above summits during the day, and locally down to 600 m late evening. Very poor visibility within low cloud otherwise mainly good.

**Temperature:** **Glens:** Plus 8 Celsius rising to plus 16 Celsius.  
**At 800m:** Plus 5 Celsius rising to plus 9 Celsius.  
**Freezing level:** Above summits.
