


National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

As temperatures fall overnight, fog is expected to form, first of all in the east of the area then further west. There remains some uncertainty regarding the location of the densest patches of fog. Although the worst of the fog should have dispersed by mid morning, some fog patches will linger for longer, especially near the coast.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Fog**

Valid from **02:00 on Sat, 24th Mar 2012** until **09:30 on Sat, 24th Mar 2012**

Fog is expected to become widespread in the early hours of Saturday and locally dense with visibility below 100 metres in places, including the outskirts of London. The fog should gradually clear on Saturday morning. The fog is likely to give rise to difficult driving conditions and may cause disruption to travel.
