Forecast for Friday 05 Jan 2024

Weather: Patchy cloud and clear spells through the overnight period. Some sunny spells during the morning but turning generally cloudier into the afternoon with scattered showers feeding in from the north by mid-afternoon. Cloud clearing east during the evening to leave prolonged clear spells by midnight.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 70% reducing to 40% for a time during the afternoon and early evening.

Low cloud and visibility: Few or scattered cloud bases 500-700m in association with showers. Visibility moderate in showers, poor in hill fog, otherwise good.

Forecast for Saturday 06 Jan 2024

Weather: Largely clear skies during the overnight period. Patchy cloud developing around dawn but plenty of sunny spells expected through the day, chance of the odd light showers during the morning. Largely clear skies into the evening, leading to the risk of some valley fog patches forming.

Maximum wind: Northwesterly 10-15 mph, reducing into the evening

Chance of cloud-free hill tops 600m: 80-90%

Low cloud and visibility: Few or scattered cloud base 600-800m at times during the day. Visibility generally good but poor in any fog patches into the evening.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 2 to plus 6 Celsius
At 600m: Zero to plus 1 Celsius
Freezing level: 800m reducing to 600m late evening
