**Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View**

A fine winter's day, although even light winds will give a bitterly cold feel. Some glare off snow covered tops.

**Forecast for Sunday 03 Dec 2023**

**Weather:** Very cold and dry with clear skies through the early hours. Then another cold largely dry day with sunny spells in the west. Patchy low cloud thickens across Easter Ross and Caithness, perhaps giving a few light snow flurries across Ben Wyvis and the Fannichs between late morning and early afternoon.

**Maximum wind:** Mainly east or southeast, 5-10 mph, gusting 15 mph.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m:** 70% in the west, 30% in the east

**Low cloud and visibility:** Very good visibility in the west. Often poor in low cloud in the east during the morning and early afternoon, with bases around 400-500m, although tops above 800m likely to be above the cloud by late afternoon.

**Temperature:** **Glens:** Minus 5 Celsius rising to minus 1 Celsius.  
**At 800m:** Minus 4 Celsius falling to minus 7 Celsius in the evening.  
**Freezing level:** 200m or less.
