Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1800 UTC Sunday 03 November to 1800 UTC Monday 04 November 2019

General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will remain over the British Isles and surrounding waters during Sunday and Monday, then will drift southeast over the Continent on Tuesday, maintaining unsettled conditions across the coastal waters.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 to 7.

Rough, occasionally very rough in southeast and moderate in shelter.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 or 6, backing north 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in southeast.

Showers.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 4 to 6, backing northeast 6 or 7.

Moderate or rough becoming very rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 near Berwick upon Tweed, backing north 4 or 5.

Very rough becoming moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 to 5, backing east 2 to 4, backing northeast 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough becoming rough or very rough later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 to 7, backing north 6 to gale 8 for a time, decreasing 4 later.

Rough or very rough, occasionally high at first in north, becoming rough later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South 2 to 4, backing southeast 2 or 3, becoming variable 3 or less, then north 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough later in north.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 2 to 4, veering northeast 5 or 6.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight at first in south.

Occasional rain or showers.
Good occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 2 to 4, backing southerly 3 to 5, becoming variable 4 or less later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 4 or less, becoming northerly 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, veering westerly 5 or 6, backing southwesterly 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in southwest.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 2 to 4, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5, then northerly 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 5 to 7, backing southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 less.

Moderate or rough becoming mainly moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming north 5 or 6.

Moderate, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 to 6, veering northwest 3 to 5 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in shelter and very rough in southwest.

Showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 3 to 5, veering north 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in shelter and very rough in southwest.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic 2 to 4, then northerly 3 to 5 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in southwest.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 3 to 5, increasing 6 or 7 in west.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in west.

Showers.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 to 5, becoming cyclonic 4 to 6, becoming variable 4 or less, then northeast 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in northeast and rough in far southwest.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 4 or 5, backing north 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in west.

Showers.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 4 or less, becoming east or southeast 4 or 5, backing northeast 4 to 6 later, occasionally 7 near Mull of Galloway.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate in north.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 4 to 6, occasionally 7 at first near Mull of Galloway, backing north 5 to 7, decreasing 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in east, and rough in far southwest.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming east 4 or 5, backing northeast 5 or 6 later.

Slight becoming moderate later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate, becoming moderate or rough, then slight or moderate later.

Occasional rain or showers, becoming fair later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming northeast 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, but smooth or slight at first in south, becoming moderate or rough later.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 to 7, backing north 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in Firth of Clyde and rough later in North Channel.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, backing northerly 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in North Channel, becoming smooth or slight later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in shelter.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 to 7, backing north 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in shelter, becoming moderate later.

Showers.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in southeast.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 to 7, backing north, veering northeast, 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in southeast, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 to 7.

Mainly rough.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 to 7, backing north, veering northeast, 4 or 5.

Rough, becoming moderate later except in north.

Showers.

Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Complex slow moving low across UK maintaining a brisk easterly flow.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Easterly or northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first in southeast
Rough or very rough

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Monday 04 Nov until 1800 UTC on Monday 04 Nov:
East or northeast 5 to 7
Rough or very rough
Fair
Good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to southwest 5 to 7, perhaps occasionally gale 8.

Rough to very rough, decreasing rather rough to rough for a time overnight and in the morning.

Occasional showers, heavy at times, perhaps locally prolonged risk of thunder, mainly from Monday morning.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to southwest 5 to 7, perhaps occasionally 8 early evening, soon decreasing 4 to 5, veering northwest late evening, then north 5 to 6 by dawn.

Rough to very rough, decreasing moderate to rather rough with a low to moderate swell overnight, locally rough by mid morning.

Frequent showers, occasionally heavy with the risk of thunder showers becoming isolated for a time Tuesday afternoon.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor.
