Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Southern Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England, dry with  
sunny spells, after the slow clearance of early frost and fog.  
Elsewhere it will be mostly dry, but cloudy, with drizzle across  
northwest Scotland and the Northern Isles and perhaps the odd spot in  
southeast England. Brighter spells should develop in the Southwest,  
and other northern areas during the afternoon. Temperatures, mostly  
near normal.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday and Saturday mostly dry, although rather cloudy and dull in  
many places. Drizzle is likely in the northwest, and also perhaps in  
southern areas later. Some bright or sunny spells in central areas  
Friday.
