General Situation

Atlantic low will move slowly east to be centred over Scotland by Monday. Strong southwesterly winds around coasts of southwestern United Kingdom. All areas becoming increasingly showery by Monday, some showers heavy and thundery.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4 , but southerly 4 or 5 near Rattray Head at first.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches mainly north, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming mainly east or northeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.
