Forecast for Monday 01 Mar 2021

Weather: A cold start with a frost then a dry day with almost unbroken sunshine. Turning chilly again after dark with a frost developing again overnight.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: Mainly 95%, but 40% in the west early this morning.

Visibility: Excellent at most elevations. Patchy cloud cover above 600m over West Coast ranges early this morning. A few fog patches in glens this morning.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

A strong UV glare off areas of lying snow, mainly above 900m. Good eye protection is recommended.

Forecast for Tuesday 02 Mar 2021

Weather: Cold start with patchy fog and frost. This soon clearing then another dry day with almost unbroken sunshine. Long clear spells in the evening with a frost developing.

Maximum wind: East or SE 5-10mph.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: Over 95%.

Visibility: Mainly excellent. Some patchy low cloud in the morning, mainly on low slopes in the east.

Temperature: **Glens:** Minus 2 or 3C rising to 8 or 9C.

At 800m: Minus 1C rising to 4C during daytime.

Freezing level: 1000-1200m, but a frost down to glen level early and late.
