Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Wet and windy weather will spread to most areas from the southwest, giving a risk of flooding across south Wales and southwest England. Gales will affect southern and western parts. Overnight, rain, wintry in the north, moves away to the northeast leaving clear spells and blustery showers.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Most areas will have sunny spells on Sunday, although heavy and blustery showers will feed in from the west in locally gale force winds. More persistent rain, also wintry in the north, crosses the country overnight, leading to another showery blustery day on Monday with continued gales in the south.
