### Forecast for Saturday 07 Oct 2023

**Weather:** Cloudy with rain, most persistent and heaviest in south of area from Knoydart across to Ben Wyvis. The rain will become lighter in north of area with some drier weather developing in the afternoon.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m:** 40%, best from Skye and Torridon up to Ben Hope.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Often misty with poor visibility in persistent rain and clouds well down the hills. Pockets of good visibility over mountains near to West Coast and over north Highlands with clouds lifting above some of the tops.

**Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View**

Very difficult walking due to persistent rain, bitterly cold feel, strong winds on tops and wet underfoot conditions.

**Forecast for Sunday 08 Oct 2023**

**Weather:** Cloudy with further rain in the morning. The rain will gradually clear away northwards during the afternoon with drier, clearer weather by evening.

**Maximum wind:** Strong south then southwest winds, average speeds of 25 to 30mph and gusts 40mph on the tops.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m:** Little chance in the morning, improving 60% during the afternoon.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Poor visibility in persistent rain during morning with extensive cloud cover down around 600m. Visibility will improve good from the south during the afternoon with clouds gradually lifting and breaking up.

**Temperature:** **Glens:** Plus 7 Celsius rising to 13 Celsius.

**At 800m:** Plus 4 Celsius.

**Freezing level:** Above the tops.
