





## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

Showers will turn heavier by the end of Thursday morning and could be accompanied by hail and thunder. 15-20mm could fall within an hour in places.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **12:00 on Thu, 03rd Aug 2017** until **19:00 on Thu, 03rd Aug 2017**

Showers will become heavy and slow-moving from late morning and through the afternoon, with some localised thundery downpours likely. This could lead to some short-lived, localised disruption to transport routes due to surface water flooding.
