General Situation

The United Kingdom remains under a slack airflow with weak fronts in western parts becoming more active with time but only slowly pushing east.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

General Situation

Low pressure in the Atlantic will push its associated fronts over Shetland and the surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Tuesday 02 Aug until 1800 UTC on Tuesday 02 Aug:

South or southeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northwest or variable 1 to 3, soon veering northeast to east, locally variable on Tuesday, occasionally 4 in the afternoon.

Smooth or slight.

Isolated showers this evening and again in the southeast later Tuesday some sea fog patches.

Mainly moderate, locally very poor in sea fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast or variable 1 to 3, becoming west Wednesday morning and southwest in the afternoon.
