Forecast for Saturday 02 Jul 2022

Weather: An early band of rain with some heavy bursts will clear for mid-morning. A day of sunny spells and well scattered showers then follows. The showers will tend to ease from mid-afternoon, allowing for a dry evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 20% chance to begin, then increasing to 80% by late morning.

Low cloud and visibility: Early rain bringing poor visibility with cloud bases at 350-450m, shrouding many paths, especially on western slopes. Cloud then rising to largely above the summits for the afternoon with very good visibility of distant hills, though showers will temporarily reduce visibility to moderate and bring cloud bases down to 600m.

Meteorologist's View

Forecast for Sunday 03 Jul 2022

Weather: Cloud building through the early hours, bringing outbreaks of rain during the first half of the morning. The cloud then lifting and breaking up to allow some sunny spells to develop for the afternoon. An isolated shower is also possible from late morning to early afternoon before these ease off and it turns largely dry from mid-afternoon and into the evening.

Maximum wind: 15mph westerly winds on the summits.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 30% through the first half of the morning, rising to 80% for the afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Low cloud around 400m covering many slopes to begin the day, chiefly in the west, with visibility also turning poor in associated rain. This cloud then lifting to above the summits for the afternoon. Visibility still reducing in any showers but remaining very good in between and turning so more widely once showers have eased.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 11 Celsius, rising to plus 19 Celsius.
At 600m: Plus 7 Celsius, rising to plus 10 Celsius.
Freezing level: Above the summits.
