Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 UTC to 1200 UTC

General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will be slow moving to the north and west of Scotland with a showery airstream covering much of the United Kingdom.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in northeast later.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming northwest 4 or 5 later.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Slight, increasing moderate in north.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering northwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times with daytime sea breezes likely.

Showers.

Good.

Slight.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering west 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.

Showers.

Good.

Slight.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering west 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Occasional rain or drizzle, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mainly moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times especially around exposed headlands.

Occasional rain or drizzle, then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mainly moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5.

Occasional rain or drizzle, then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Moderate occasionally slight.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

West backing southwest 4 or 5.

Occasional rain or drizzle, then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Showers.

Good.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, veering west, then veering northwest 2 or 3 later.

Showers.

Good, possibly moderate in showers.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering northwest 3 or 4, becoming variable for a time.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering north 3 or 4.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate.

Shetland Isles

24 hour forecast:

Southeast backing northwest 2 or 3, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Moderate, occasionally slight.

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
