Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1800 UTC Tuesday 03 May to 1800 UTC Wednesday 04 May 2016

General Situation

High pressure, currently centred over northern France, will gradually move eastwards overnight maintaining the calm conditions over much of the southeast for the next 48 hours at least. Elsewhere, low pressure in the mid Atlantic will push weather fronts across northwestern areas, bringing strong winds and rain at times.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly backing southerly, 5 or 6, increasing 7 at times later in northwest, perhaps gale 8 later in northwest.
Slight or moderate in east, moderate or rough occasionally very rough at first in north.
Showers then occasional rain and drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in northwest.
Slight or moderate in east, moderate or rough becoming very rough at times later in north.
Occasional rain or drizzle, mainly in north.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southerly 5 to 7.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain or drizzle at first.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

Southwest 5 or 6 backing south 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times later.
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough at times later.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southwest 5 to 7.
Rough or very rough, becoming high for a time in northwest.
Occasional rain or drizzle.

The Minch - (SWW)

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low pressure near Iceland will fill as another low tracks northwards towards Iceland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southerly gale force 8 in operation at time of issue.

Southwest backing south 5 or 6.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in west.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Wednesday 04 May until 1800 UTC on Wednesday 04 May:

South 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northwest to west 1 to 3, locally 4 in the north at first, becoming variable by midnight, then southeast 3 to 4 by dawn, locally variable 1 to 3 near the french coast, veering east to northeast later.

Mainly slight.

Fair or fine risk of early morning mist patches near the french coast.

Good, perhaps locally moderate to poor early morning.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly 2 to 4, veering southeast for a time overnight.

Slight with a low swell.

Fair or fine risk of early morning mist patches near the french coast.

Good, perhaps locally moderate to poor early morning.

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
