General Situation

Low pressure over or near the British Isles will maintain the current run of changeable weather.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Slight or moderate in north, slight in south.

Rain or showers, fog patches in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming east or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southeast becoming variable then northeast, 3 or 4, occasionally 2 at first, increasing 5 at times later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Showers, then rain later, fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast becoming cyclonic 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Rain at times.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 2 at first.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, then rain later.

Moderate or good becoming moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable or cyclonic 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then becoming west or northwest 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor becoming moderate or good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers then rain.

Moderate or good becoming moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable or cyclonic becoming west, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor becoming good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then becoming variable.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Showers then rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate.

Rain then fair.

Moderate, occasionally poor at first, becoming good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later, but becoming variable 3 or less for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers, then rain for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later, but becoming variable 3 or less for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers, then rain for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 or 6, backing south or southeast 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4 veering northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly, backing southeasterly later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time, then increasing 6 later in west.

Slight or moderate.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 3 or 4 veering northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest, backing southeast later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, then decreasing 3 for a time.
Slight or moderate.
Showers then fair.
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 3 or 4 veering west or northwest 4 or 5.
Slight, becoming slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate.
Showers then fair.
Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or 4, occasionally 2 at first, becoming northwest 4 or 5 later.
Slight, becoming slight or moderate.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwesterly backing westerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, then backing westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or showers, becoming fair later.
Moderate or good.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest 3 or 4 veering northwest 4 or 5.
Slight, becoming slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest 4 or 5, backing southwest 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming slight later.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
Southerly 4 or 5 at first in east, otherwise variable 3 or 4 becoming northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5 becoming variable 3 or 4, then becoming southerly 4 or 5 later in southeast.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel
24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 2, then northwest 4 or 5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, backing southwest 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Variable, becoming northwest later, 3 or 4, then increasing 5 later near the Mull of Kintyre.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest 4 or 5, backing southwest 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

The Minch
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 at times later.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable mainly southwest 3 or 4 becoming north or northeast 4 or 5, then becoming cyclonic 5 or 6.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 west of the Outer Hebrides, becoming variable 2 at times in east.
Slight near Sutherland, otherwise moderate.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable mainly southwest 3 or 4 becoming north or northeast 4 or 5, then becoming cyclonic 5 or 6.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Lows south and west of Shetland extend troughs towards Shetland rest of Tuesday and Wednesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southeasterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 in southwest.
Moderate.

Rain mostly clearing in east later, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Wednesday 04 Jun until 1800 UTC on
Wednesday 04 Jun:

Southeasterly backing easterly, 4 or 5, but variable 3 or 4 at first in
southwest.

Moderate, becoming slight in east.

Rain or showers in west, clearing for a time, fog patches at first in southwest.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 2 to 4 becoming south or variable 1 to 3 this evening, then west to
northwest tomorrow morning, increasing 5 to 6 by midday.

Slight becoming moderate to rather rough by early afternoon.

Rain from mid-evening, clearing around midday.

Good becoming moderate to poor in rain.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest to west 5 to 6 decreasing 4 to 5 in the evening, then 3 to 4
overnight, becoming southwest to south or variable 1 to 3 by early afternoon.

Moderate to rather rough becoming smooth or slight with swell.

Fair.
