



National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

Wintry showers will continue to run in off the North Sea through Sunday evening and night. Many of these showers will fall as snow, though in areas on and very near the coast showers are more likely to fall as a mixture of sleet, snow and hail. Where showers are most frequent localised accumulations of between 1 and 3 cm could occur, although over the North Yorkshire Moors accumulations are likely to be locally higher and closer to 5 cm. Surfaces which are either untreated or see showers washing off any earlier treatment will readily become icy in these showers.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Snow and Ice**

Valid from **19:00 on Sun, 06th Mar 2016** until **09:00 on Mon, 07th Mar 2016**

Wintry showers during Sunday evening and night will allow ice to form readily on untreated surfaces and where showers wash off earlier road treatment. Where showers are most frequent, localised accumulations of between 1 and 3 cm could occur.

Please be aware of the potential for difficult driving conditions and slippery surfaces.
