


# National Severe Weather Warning Service



**Chief Forecasters Assessment**  
 Including what has fallen on Saturday night, rainfall totals of 30 to 50 mm are expected widely with local totals of 70 mm to 90 mm. Winds will gust to 60-70 mph for a time during the morning, and more on high ground, before slowly coming down through the afternoon.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **08:00 on Sun, 28th Aug 2011** until **22:00 on Sun, 28th Aug 2011**

A spell of wet and unseasonably windy weather will continue during Sunday. Persistent rain, heavy at times, will be accompanied by strong to gale force winds with a risk of severe gales in the most exposed areas. The public should be aware of the risk of localised flooding.
