Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1200 UTC Tuesday 01 October to 1200 UTC Wednesday 02 October  
2019

#### General Situation

A complex area of low pressure over England and Wales will edge away eastwards, allowing a cool northerly airflow already over Scotland to spread southwards to all areas by Wednesday morning. Thereafter, a long ridge of high pressure will edge eastwards, bringing fine and quiet conditions to most areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time later in east. Slight or moderate in inner Moray Firth, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough for a time.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4, veering easterly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 4 or 5, backing northwesterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later in north.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough in far north and far south.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Rough at first in far south and until later in far north, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers at first in north.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south, backing northwesterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain then showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later, then becoming variable.

Rough becoming moderate.

Showers at first.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast backing northwest later, 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough.

Rain then showers.

Mainly moderate, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.  
Moderate, occasionally rough at first.  
Showers at first.  
Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4 at first in central areas, otherwise cyclonic becoming northeasterly 5 to 7, backing northwesterly later.  
Slight at times in south, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Occasional rain or showers, thundery at first.  
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.  
Moderate or rough at first in north, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later in south.  
Showers at first.  
Good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4, veering northerly 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 in east, then backing northwesterly 4 or 5 later.  
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.  
Thundery showers, fair later.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4, then veering north 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.  
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.  
Thundery showers, fair later.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then south 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time.  
Fair.  
Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly veering northerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time in west, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in west, becoming slight or moderate later.  
Showers, fair later.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming southerly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later in west.  
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later in west.  
Fair.  
Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 for a time in west, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, but very rough at first in west, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers, fair later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 or 5 becoming variable 3 or less, then southerly 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 4 or 5 at first in south, otherwise north 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough occasionally very rough at first in west, becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers, becoming fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then south or southeast 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time in north.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 6 to gale 8, backing north or northwest 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate, then smooth later in shelter.

Occasional rain or showers, becoming fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then southeast 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight for a time.

Fair.

Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5, backing northwest later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain then mainly fair.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then becoming southeast 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, but gale 8 at first in southeast, backing northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Rough at first in southeast, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later.

Occasional rain then showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then southeasterly 5 to 7 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Fair.

Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, but gale 8 at first in southeast, backing northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Rough at first in far south, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later.

Occasional rain then fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then southeasterly 5 or 6 later, occasionally 7 in North Channel.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Fair.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast backing north 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then southeast 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight for a time.

Fair.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate in south, moderate or rough in north.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5, veering east 3 or 4, then southeast 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight for a time in south, moderate or rough in north.

Showers at first.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate between barra and canna, but elsewhere moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5, veering east 3 or 4, then southeast 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate at first in south, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers at first.

Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

## Shetland Isles

### General Situation

A strong, showery mainly northerly airstream covers Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

North or northwest 5 to 7

Rough or very rough

Squally showers

Mainly good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Wednesday 02 Oct until 1200 UTC on  
Wednesday 02 Oct:

North or northwest 5 to 7

Very rough at first in west, otherwise rough

Squally showers

Mainly good

### Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to southwest 4 to 6, locally 7 at times, veering northwest this evening,  
then north to northeast by midnight, decreasing 3 to 5 later.

Rather rough to rough, gradually decreasing overnight to become mainly moderate  
by dawn, then slight later.

Scattered showers, locally heavy with a risk of hail and thunder, clearing  
overnight.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 3 to 4, becoming variable 1 to 2 for overnight, then southerly 2 to 4  
by Thursday morning, locally 5 later.

Slight to moderate, decreasing smooth to slight during the evening, with a low  
swell.

Fair occasionally fine.

Good.

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
