General Situation

A west to northwesterly airflow will prevail across the British Isles during the next 24 hours.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

Northwesterly 3 to 5.

Slight throughout in Firth of Clyde, but elsewhere slight or moderate.
Showers then fair.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwest 4 to 6.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or northwest 3 to 5.
Slight or moderate, becoming slight later.
Showers then fair, then occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

The Minch
24 hour forecast:
West or northwest 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Low over Sweden, with associated front clearing Shetland by start of period,
will hold a showery NW'ly flow across the area. Pressure gradually building from
the southwest into Tuesday.

Northwest 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later
Moderate, occasionally rough

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Tuesday 02 Jul until 1200 UTC on Tuesday
02 Jul:

Northwesterly backing westerly later 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north
Moderate, but slight in lee shelter to east of Shetland

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 3 to 4, locally 5 at times, veering north to northeast 4 to 5
overnight.

Slight, locally moderate.

first, locally variable 2 to 3 mid-channel for a time during the afternoon,
