Forecast for Sunday 02 Apr 2023

Weather: Mostly cloudy on Sunday morning with some hill fog, and some light, patchy rain, this dying out during the morning. Cloud then gradually lifting and then in the afternoon, breaking at times to allow some sunny intervals, the cloud becoming patchy by late afternoon with a sunny end to the day. Staying mainly clear after dark with patchy cloud.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 20% until mid morning lifting 75% by afternoon than more than 90% in the late afternoon and evening.

Low cloud and visibility: Cloud at 500-750m at first, lifting up to then above the tops during the morning and then becoming more broken in the afternoon. Occasionally poor visibility at first in drizzle but then becoming good away from cloud, if rather hazy.

Meteorologist's View

Some uncertainty over time of cloud breaks but a gradually improving day.

Forecast for Monday 03 Apr 2023

Weather: A cloudier spell overnight and into the morning but dry, the cloud then breaking up to bring some sunny spells in the afternoon.

Maximum wind: Southeast 25 gusts 35mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 30% in morning rising 80% in afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Cloud at 500-750m in morning clearing in afternoon, away from cloud good visibility though with some haze.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 4 Celsius at dawn rising to Plus 9 in the afternoon.

At 700m: Plus 2 Celsius.

Freezing level: Just above the summits.
