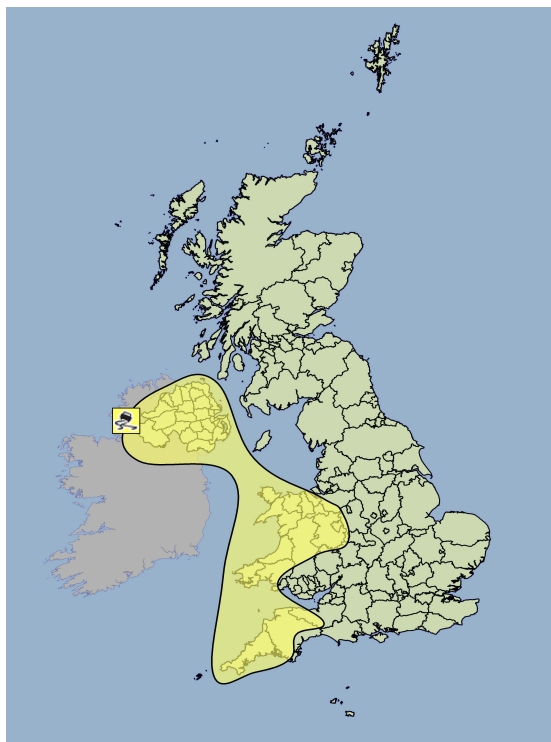




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

clear skies will allow temperatures to fall widely below freezing allowing icy patches to develop, particularly on untreated surfaces or where overnight showers washes off earlier road treatment. Showers are also likely to be wintry even to low levels over Northern Ireland to given some localised and patchy accumulations of snow here. Over Wales snow showers are expected above 200 to 300 m and accumulations of 1 to 2 cm of snow are possible here.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Ice**

Valid from **21:00 on Sat, 05th Mar 2016** until **09:00 on Sun, 06th Mar 2016**

Icy patches are expected to form during Saturday evening and night especially on untreated surfaces and where showers occur after dark. In addition, showers are likely to fall as snow at times over Northern Ireland and above 200 to 300 m in Wales, giving some patchy accumulations of snow here.

Please be aware of the potential for difficult driving conditions and slippery surfaces.
