Forecast for Wednesday 01 Sep 2021

Weather: Dry across all ranges throughout the day. There will some cloud around although amounts uncertain. Some sunnier breaks too, the best of the sunshine most likely across the southwest of the area.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 60%

Visibility: Generally very good with good air clarity outside of cloud. Some low cloud around 700 metres, this most prevalent across the north and east of the area, and it is possible that the tops may stand clear of the cloud above the inversion.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Feeling rather cold at height under any cloud cover.

Forecast for Thursday 02 Sep 2021

Weather: Remaining dry with variable amounts of cloud, again amounts will be uncertain.

Maximum wind: Easterly 10 mph

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 60%

Visibility: Generally very good with good air clarity. Some patchy cloud between 500 and 700 metres although the tops may stand clear above the cloud.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 11 rising to 17 Celsius

At 800m: Plus 12 Celsius

Freezing level: Above summits
