General Situation

A bitterly cold and strong to gale force easterly wind extends across the country. A deep area of low pressure will move northwards from Biscay into the Southwest Approaches overnight and during Friday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

General Situation
Intense high over Scandinavia maintains a cold easterly airstream across
Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue

Easterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later
Moderate, occasionally rough in south and slight in sheltered western waters
Snow showers dying out
Good, occasionally poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Friday 02 Mar until 1800 UTC on Friday 02 Mar:

Easterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in south

Moderate, occasionally rough in far south

Mainly fair

Mainly good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East to northeast 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in the north of the area, veering south to southwest 4 to 5 around midday.

Moderate to rather rough in the southeast and rough to very rough in the north, locally slight in the south by midday.

Misty with outbreaks of freezing rain or snow, very soon turning to rain and sleet this evening, then rain by morning, clearing in the south by midday.

Moderate to poor, becoming moderate to good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 3 to 5, backing southeast to east 5 to 6 after midnight and increasing 5 to 7 during Saturday morning.

Moderate to rather rough, becoming slight in the south of the area with an increasing swell.

Outbreaks of rain, most likely Saturday afternoon.

Moderate to poor, occasionally moderate to good.

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
