Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0000 UTC Sunday 04 June to 0000 UTC Monday 05 June 2017

#### General Situation

A ridge of high pressure extending across the United Kingdom from the south will decline later on Sunday and during Monday. A deep area of low pressure will northeastwards across Scotland on Monday with another area of low pressure moving across England and Wales later on Monday and during Tuesday.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming mainly south or southeast later, 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight in southeast, slight or moderate in north.  
Showers, fog patches at first.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth for a time in southeast.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 until later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers, fog patches at first.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 or 4, backing southeast 5 or 6 until later.  
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing southeast for a time later, 3 or 4 increasing 5 at times.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair, then showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 5 or 6, veering northwest 3 or 4 later.  
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.  
Showers, then occasional rain.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly backing southeasterly for a time later, 3 or 4 increasing 5 at times.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair, then showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in north.  
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers, occasional rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly backing southerly for a time later, 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight.

Fair, showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, backing southerly 5 to 7 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly backing southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time later in east.

Smooth or slight.

Fair, showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, backing southerly 5 to 7 perhaps gale 8 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Westerly backing southwesterly 4 or 5.

Slight.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, backing southerly 5 to 7 perhaps gale 8 later, then veering northwesterly in west.

Slight becoming moderate.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

West backing southwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, backing south then veering northwest later, 5 to 7 perhaps gale 8.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Showers, then occasional rain until later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor until later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 or 6, backing south then veering northwest later, 5 to 7 perhaps gale 8.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Fair, then occasional rain, showers later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor until later.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers for a time.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 or 6, backing south 5 to 7, veering northwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time in south.

Fair, then occasional rain, showers later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor until later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 or 6, backing south 5 to 7, veering north or northwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair, then occasional rain, showers later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor, until later.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, veering west or southwest, then veering northwest later, 5 or 6 occasionally 7 at first.

Moderate occasionally rough at first.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming south or southwest backing southeast later, 4 or 5 occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast veering southwest, 5 or 6 increasing 7 at times, veering northwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southerly or southwesterly backing southeasterly later, 4 or 5 occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly veering southwesterly, 5 or 6 increasing 7 at times, veering northwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southwesterly then backing southeasterly later, 4 or 5 occasionally 6 for a time in north.

Moderate.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7, becoming northwesterly 4 or 5 occasionally 6 for a time later.

Moderate.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 3 or 4, backing northeast 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.

Moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 3 or 4, backing northeast 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 5 or 6 later.

Moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Light winds throughout.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

East or southeast 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate

Ocasional rain with fog patches at first, then showers

Moderate occasionally very poor at first, becoming good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Sunday 04 Jun until 0000 UTC on Monday 05 Jun:

East or southeast, becoming variable, 3 or 4

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West 3 to 4, backing southwest to south by midday and decreasing 2 to 3 jersey southward.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Isolated showers Sunday afternoon, dying out overnight.

Good, locally moderate in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southwest 3 to 4, increasing 4 to 5 Monday morning, then 6 to 7 in the afternoon, veering west to northwest in the evening perhaps gale 8 with gusts to 50kt.

Slight to moderate increasing moderate to rather rough in the afternoon, occasionally rough.

Rain spreading from the west Monday afternoon, perhaps heavy with a risk of thunder.

Good becoming moderate to poor in rain.

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
