Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1800 UTC Monday 03 June to 1800 UTC Tuesday 04 June 2019

General Situation

A large low to the north of Scotland will slowly move away to the north tonight, then another low will cross from the southwest on Tuesday bringing strong winds at times and some rain or thundery showers in many areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming north 4 to 6, decreasing 2 or 3 later.

Slight or moderate in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain.

Moderate or poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 2 to 4, becoming northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.

Slight.

Rain, then showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good later.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, for a time, then veering southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable later.

Slight.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing southeast, 4 to 6, decreasing 3 for a time.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Thundery showers later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast, veering southwest 4 to 6, decreasing 2 or 3 later and becoming variable.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly, backing southeasterly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Mainly fair at first, then thundery rain or showers later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly veering southwesterly for a time, 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Thundery rain or showers for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly, backing southeasterly 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair at first, then thundery rain or showers later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly veering southwesterly, 3 to 5.

Slight.

Rain or showers, thundery for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, backing southerly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later in west.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers later, perhaps thundery in afternoon.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4.

Slight.

Showers, thundery near shore.

Good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest, 3 to 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers later, perhaps thundery in afternoon.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, thundery near shore.

Good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest, 3 to 5.

Moderate, occasionally slight later.

Showers or rain, thundery later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest veering northwest later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic 2 to 4.
Slight or moderate.
Showers then rain.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic 2 to 4, becoming northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 for a time.
Slight, occasionally moderate.
Showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.
Slight or moderate.
Showers, rain later.
Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time.
Slight, occasionally moderate.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic, 3 to 5.
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later in shelter.
Showers, rain later.
Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time.
Slight, occasionally moderate.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwesterly 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 3 or less, then north 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later in west.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in northwest.
Showers, rain later, perhaps thundery in east.
Good, occasionally poor in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in northwest.
Rain, thundery for a time.
Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel
24 hour forecast:
Southwesterly 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic and decreasing 3 or 4 for a time.
Moderate, occasionally slight later.
Showers or rain, thundery for a time.
Good, occasionally moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 3 or 4, becoming northerly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near Mull of Kintyre.

Rain, thundery for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, veering north 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5 increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Moderate or rough, but slight inshore.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, veering north 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 5 or 6 occasionally gale 7 at first near Cape Wrath, veering north 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Monday 03 Jun 2019 at 1800 UTC until Tuesday 04 Jun 2019 at 0600 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A complex low northwest of Shetland continues to move away north over the next 24 hours.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue:

Southwesterly gale force 8 expected soon (issued 2144 UTC on Sunday 2 June 2019)

Southerly 5 or 6 soon veering southwesterly 6 to gale 8

Moderate or rough

Showers

Mainly good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Tuesday 04 Jun until 1800 UTC on Tuesday 04 Jun:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later in south

Mainly rough, becoming moderate in south and east

Showers dying out

Mainly good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable or southwest 1 to 3, becoming mainly southeasterly 2 to 4 before midnight, locally 5 Tuesday morning, veering southwest to west and increasing 4 to 6 in the afternoon, perhaps locally 7 later.

Smooth or slight.

Isolated light showers, then rain arriving in the west of the area after dawn, spreading eastwards, locally heavy with a risk of thunder, clearing from mid-afternoon.

Good, occasionally moderate, perhaps locally poor in any heavy rain tomorrow.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 to 6, perhaps locally 7 at first, becoming northwest 2 to 4 by midday.

Slight, perhaps occasionally moderate in the west of the area, with a low swell.

Risk of isolated showers from midnight.

Good, perhaps occasionally moderate in any showers.
