Forecast for Monday 01 Apr 2024

**Weather:** Cloudy with patchy drizzle at first on Monday, becoming drier and brighter through the morning with occasionally sunny spells. Scattered showers then develop from late morning, some of which may be heavy at times with the risk of thunder. Any showers dying out with clear spells in the evening, perhaps some mist patches forming.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m:** 30% at first, rising to 90% by midday.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Occasional or extensive cloud, base 300 to 600m first thing. Cloud lifting and breaking near or above the summits in the morning. Visibility moderate to very poor, becoming mostly good or very good by midday.

Forecast for Tuesday 02 Apr 2024

**Weather:** Patchy rain and low cloud overnight and early morning. The cloud then lifting and breaking with some sunny spells developing along with scattered or isolated showers. Rain and lowering cloud in the evening.

**Maximum wind:** South or Southwest 10 to 15mph, later Southeast 20 gusting 30mph.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops 600m:** 50% becoming 90% around midday, lowering 30% in the evening

**Low cloud and visibility:** Occasional or extensive cloud, base 600m early and later in the day, otherwise cloud mainly above the summits.

**Temperature:** **Valleys:** Plus 5 rising to 14 Celsius in the afternoon  
**At 600m:** Plus 3 rising to Plus 7 Celsius in the afternoon  
**Freezing level:** Above the summits.
