**Forecast for Sunday 07 Mar 2021**

**Weather:** Mainly dry with bright spells. Thicker cloud could bring some patchy light rain late in the day.

**Maximum wind:** West or Northwest 10 to 20mph.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m:** 80% becoming 40% in the evening.

**Visibility:** Mainly very good, but moderate in any rain, perhaps poor over the tops late in the day with extensive cloud, base 700 to 900m possible in the evening.

**Temperature:** **Valleys:** Zero Celsius rising to Plus 8 Celsius

**At 800m:** Minus 2 Celsius rising to plus 2 Celsius during the day.

**Freezing level:** Well down at first, but rising to near or above the summits by the end of the day.
