Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Sunday 03 November to 1200 UTC Monday 04 November 2013

General Situation

An area of low pressure in the northern North Sea will pass to the east today, but another deep Atlantic low will run eastwards across southern England for Sunday night, before eventually clearing into Sweden by Tuesday morning.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 or 6, becoming variable 4, then southeast 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10 at first in far north, decreasing 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in north.

Occasional rain then showers.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 to 7, becoming variable 4, then south 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Showers for a time.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5, then veering northwest 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough.

Squally showers, becoming fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 to 7, backing southwest 4.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4, then veering northwest 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers then fair, rain later in south.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 or 6, backing southwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers for a time.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly, becoming cyclonic, then northerly or northwesterly later, 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Squally showers, then rain for a time.

Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, backing westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight in Thames estuary.

Showers, then rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly, becoming cyclonic, then northerly or northwesterly later, 6 to gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough for a time.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasional poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, backing westerly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later in west.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough.

Showers, then rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, becoming cyclonic, then north or northwest later, 6 to gale 8, decreasing 5 later.

Rough or very rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasional poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 5, backing west 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7 later.

Rough or very rough.

Showers, then rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, becoming cyclonic for a time, 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 later, veering north 4 later.

Rough or very rough, occasionally high in west.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasional poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest, backing west, 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7 later.

Rough or very rough, occasionally high in west.

Showers, then rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 6 to gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9 later in south, then northerly 4 later.

Very rough or high, becoming rough or very rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasional poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 3 or 4, backing west 4 or 5, then veering northwest 5 to 7 later.

Rough or very rough, occasionally high in far southwest.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasional poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 5 or 6, becoming variable 4, then east or northeast 5 to 7, backing northwest 4 or 5 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate later.

Squally showers, rain for a time in south.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest, backing west or southwest, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Moderate, becoming rough in south.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4, then north or northwest 4 or 5 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers, squally at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest, backing west or southwest, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West veering north or northwest, 5 or 6 decreasing 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Moderate, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, backing south or southwest 5 or 6, veering west or northwest 6 or 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers, squally at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3, then south or southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight in east, moderate in north.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North

Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers, squally at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3, then south or southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 5 or 6, veering north 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, squally at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest, backing south, then veering west later, 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 5 or 6, veering north 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight in shelter.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 4, then cyclonic 5 to 7 later.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 5 or 6, veering north 4 or 5 later.

Rough.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 4, then cyclonic 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Sunday 03 Nov 2013 at 1200 UTC until Monday 04 Nov 2013 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low pressure centred over the east Shetland basin moves slowly into Norway.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Northwest severe gale 9

Northerly or northwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first.
Rough.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Monday 04 Nov until 1200 UTC on Monday 04 Nov:

Northerly 6 to gale 8, occasionally 5 later in west.
Rough or very rough.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 6 to 7, backing southwest to south this afternoon, decreasing 5 to 6 for a time, increasing 7 to gale 8 this evening, veering west overnight, locally severe gale 9 with gusts to 60kt, further veering northwest around dawn decreasing 5 to 6, then 4 in the morning.
Rough to very rough becoming slight to moderate tomorrow.
Rain from mid-afternoon, locally heavy this evening, becoming intermittent overnight, clearing around dawn.
Good, becoming moderate to poor in rain.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 3 to 4 backing southwest to south decreasing 2 or 3 in the evening, veering southwest to west 3 to 4 overnight, further veering west to northwest increasing 5 to 6 in the morning.
Slight to moderate with swell becoming moderate to rather rough later.
Occasional rain on Tuesday.
Good becoming moderate to poor in rain.

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
