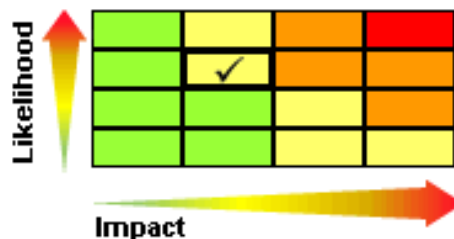
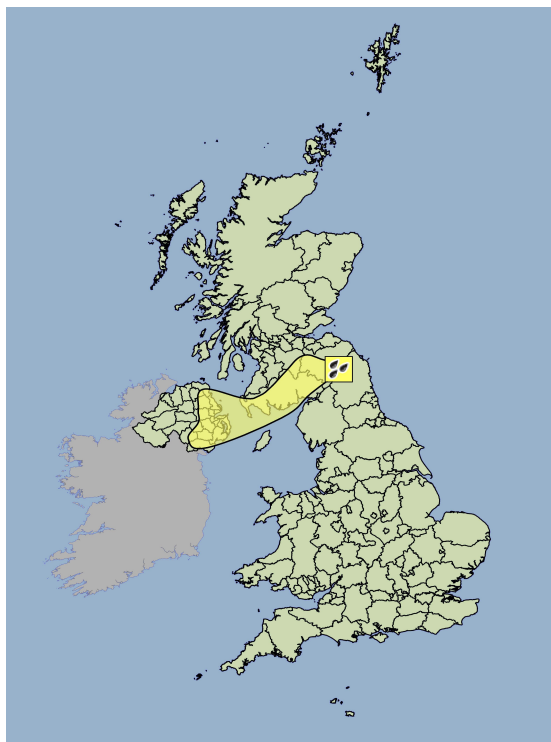




## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

An area of low pressure to the west of the UK will push active frontal systems across the UK on Friday. The rain associated will be heavy at times, falling onto saturated ground, with 20 to 30 mm likely within around 6 hours.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Alert of Rain**

Valid from **09:00 on Fri, 25th Oct 2013** until **18:00 on Fri, 25th Oct 2013**

A band of rain will move northwards across southern Scotland and Northern Ireland, this turning heavy, especially over the higher ground. The public should be aware that some localised flooding is possible.
