#### General Situation

Over the next 3 days, a large area of high pressure will remain slow moving near Norway while low pressure over the north Atlantic gradually moves eastwards, the associated weather fronts edging slowly eastwards across all except some northeastern parts of the United Kingdom.

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure over Shetland will move slowly east over the next few days.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 2 to 4, becoming variable this afternoon then east tonight, veering southeast to south by dawn tomorrow.

Slight.

Mist or fog patches, especially near french coasts, this morning and again overnight risk of a shower from this afternoon onwards.

Moderate locally poor or very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast to south 2 to 4, veering south to southwest on Monday.

Slight with swell.

Occasional showers.

Moderate to good, perhaps locally poor.

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
