Weather: A bright day with some sunny spells, the best of these expected around Ben Lawers and the more sheltered southwest. Cloud more extensive across the Aberdeenshire and Angus hills with the odd light shower possible.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 70% becoming 90% by afternoon.

Visibility: Mostly very good or excellent, but moderate or poor in morning summit cloud and showers. Occasional or extensive cloud, base mainly above the summits, but occasional 600 to 900m during the morning, particularly in the north.

Forecast for Monday 02 Aug 2021

Weather: Dry and bright with some sunny or clear spells.

Maximum wind: Variable 5 to 10mph.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 70% becoming 90% by afternoon.

Visibility: Mostly very good, perhaps moderate or poor in any early summit cloud. Generally no significant cloud, but patches around the summits possible early morning.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 8 Celsius rising to 18 Celsius.

At 800m: Plus 5 to 10 Celsius

Freezing level: Above the summits
