Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1800 UTC Tuesday 01 June to 1800 UTC Wednesday 02 June 2021

General Situation

The ridge over the North Sea will decline for a time this evening and into Wednesday, as a thundery low over biscay will move north or northwest towards Ireland and weaken before moving west into the Atlantic on Thursday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming southeast 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in inner Moray Firth.

Fog patches at first and later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4.

Slight, becoming smooth or slight for a time.

Extensive fog at first and later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate in east.

Fog patches becoming extensive later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southeast backing east, 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally smooth.

Extensive fog at first and later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fog patches becoming extensive later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

East 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally smooth at first.

Fog patches later in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later in north.

East or northwest 3 or 4.
Slight, occasionally moderate in northeast.
Showers, fog banks later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland
24 hour forecast:
Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5.
Slight, occasionally smooth at first.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northeasterly 4 becoming variable 3 or less.
Slight, occasionally smooth later in the wash and Thames estuary.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill
24 hour forecast:
Northeasterly 4 or 5 veering easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4.
Slight, becoming smooth or slight later.
Showers later.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less, then westerly or southwesterly 2 to 4.
Smooth or slight.
Showers, fog patches later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis
24 hour forecast:
East 4 or 5 veering southeast 2 or 3.
Slight, occasionally smooth near shore.
Thundery showers in west.
Good, occasionally moderate in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast 2 or 3 veering southwest 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Showers, fog patches.
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 4 or 5 veering south or southeast 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southeast 3 or 4 veering southwest 3 to 5.
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in Lyme bay.
Showers, fog patches.
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

East 2 to 4 veering southeast 3 or 4.

Slight, but smooth in east and moderate in southwest.

Thundery showers later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 3 or 4 veering south 3 to 5, then southwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate in west, smooth or slight in east.

Showers, fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 2 to 4 veering east 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 3 or 4, veering southeast, then south, 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far southwest and far northwest.

Showers, fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 3 or 4 veering east 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth becoming smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 4 or less, then south or southwest 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 2 or 3 veering east 4 or 5.

Smooth becoming mainly slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 4 to 6, veering southeast 3 or 4, then south 4 or 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate in south and west.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 2 to 4 veering east 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate in north, otherwise smooth becoming slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
East 3 to 5, veering southeast 4 to 6.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less becoming easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 4 to 6, veering southeasterly 3 to 5.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in North Channel.
Showers.
Mainly good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
North 2 to 4 veering east or northeast 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate.
Showers later.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
East or northeast 3 or 4 veering southeast 5 or 6.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good.

The Minch
24 hour forecast:
North veering northeast, 2 to 4, becoming variable 3 or less for a time.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far north and in far south.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northeast 2 to 4, veering southeast 3 to 5.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far north and later in south.
Showers.
Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath
24 hour forecast:
North veering northeast, 2 to 4, becoming variable 3 or less for a time.
Moderate, occasionally rough at first in northwest.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northeast 2 to 4, veering southeast 3 to 5.
Moderate, occasionally slight later.
Showers.
Good.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High pressure across Scandinavia brings a strengthening southeasterly flow over Shetland Waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil.

Variable 3 or less at first in west, otherwise southerly 3 backing southeasterly 4 or 5.

Moderate, but slight in waters east of Shetland.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Wednesday 02 Jun until 1800 UTC on Wednesday 02 Jun:

Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Moderate, but slight in waters east of Shetland until later.

Fog banks.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

East to northeast 4 to 5, becoming east to southeast 2 to 4 by dawn, then southeast to south 3 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight, with a low swell developing in the west of the area.

Showers by midnight, locally heavy and perhaps thundery mist or fog patches developing by dawn.

Good becoming moderate, locally poor or very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southeast 2 to 4, becoming southwest to west by midnight then west to northwest later.

Smooth or slight, with a low swell.

Mist or fog patches, clearing later rain or showers developing after dawn.

Moderate, locally poor or very poor, occasionally good.

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
