General Situation

Low pressure near Iceland will gradually move northeastwards, whilst pressure remains relatively high across Europe. Later on Monday, a new area of low pressure will edge northeastwards towards the United Kingdom.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 at times later.

Slight or moderate in east, moderate or rough in north.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

Slight or moderate in west, smooth or slight in east.
Fog patches, mainly in east, rain later in west.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

Southwest backing south 3 or 4.
Moderate, becoming slight in east.
Fog patches later, mainly in east.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate in west, smooth or slight in east.
Fog patches, mainly in east, rain later in west.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

Southwesterly backing southerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in northwest.
Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly, backing southeasterly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Slight or moderate.

Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

South or southwest 4 or 5, backing south 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South backing southeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight in Liverpool Bay, otherwise slight or moderate.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming mainly moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

South or southwest 4 or 5, backing south 3 or 4.

Moderate, becoming slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Southerly backing southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.

South, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming southeast 5 or 6 later.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in west.

The Minch - (SWW)

Slight or moderate, but rough in far north and far south.

East to southeast 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mist or fog patches, mainly in the north of the area.
