Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0600 UTC Sunday 03 October to 0600 UTC Monday 04 October 2010

General Situation

A deep area of low pressure will remain slow moving to the south of Iceland and fill. A waving front stretching from the North Sea across southern England will develop at times bringing strong winds and heavy rain to parts of the United Kingdom. A new Atlantic low will then arrive to the west of the United Kingdom later tomorrow becoming the dominant feature.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times, veering south later, occasionally 7 near Cape Wrath.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Mainly south 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first, perhaps gale 8 later near Cape Wrath.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in Moray Firth.

Rain later.

Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, becoming variable 3 or 4 for a time then southwesterly later.

Mainly moderate.

Occasional rain or showers becoming mainly fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5 backing southerly or southeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Mainly moderate, occasionally slight in south.

Occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4 increasing 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming southerly 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4 increasing 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Mainly southerly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in south, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Mainly moderate.

Fair then rain.

Good becoming moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic or southerly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Mainly moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Mainly southerly 4 or 5 increasing 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5 later, occasionally 3.

Mainly moderate.

Rain.

Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times, becoming westerly or southwesterly later.

Mainly moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first, veering northerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Mainly moderate.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly backing westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Mainly moderate.

Occasional rain at first and later.

Moderate or good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 5 to 7, but 7 to severe gale 9 at first in east, becoming westerly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times, then veering northerly.

Moderate or rough.

Rain becoming mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly backing westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Rain later.

Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic or southerly 5 or 6 becoming westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4.

Moderate, occasionally rough in west and slight in east.

Rain becoming fair.

Moderate or poor becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 3 or 4 backing southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Mainly moderate.

Rain later.

Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly veering westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable at times later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in south.

Occasional rain or showers becoming fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair then occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, veering west or southwest 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers becoming fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4 backing southerly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 in northwest, then decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.

Rain later.

Moderate or good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, veering southwest 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 or 4 backing south 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time, then veering southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.

Rain later.

Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in northwest.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 or 4 increasing 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time.

Mainly moderate, occasionally rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4 increasing 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time in North Channel.

Mainly moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly veering southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in north and 4 in south.

Mainly rough.

Squally showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 5 or 6 backing southerly 6 to gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9 for a time.

Mainly rough becoming very rough later.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly veering southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 4 at first north of skye and 7 later.

Rough or very rough south of skye, but mainly moderate to north.

Squally showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7 backing south 6 to gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9 for a time.

Rough or very rough south of skye, but mainly moderate to north.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Rough or very rough.

Squally showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7 backing south 6 to gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9 for a time.

Very rough, occasionally high later.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Sunday 03 Oct 2010 at 0600 UTC until Sunday 03 Oct 2010 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A mainly strong southerly airflow but a small wave depression will track north close to the east of Shetland during Sunday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southeast 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later, but cyclonic 4 or 5 in far east for a time.

Rough, but occasionally very rough at first.

Occasional rain, heavy at times in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in east.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Sunday 03 Oct until 0600 UTC on Monday 04 Oct:

Southeast 4 or 5 veering south or southwest 5 to 7, but veering west 3 or 4 in east for a time.

Mainly rough.

Rain slowly clearing eastwards, then a few showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in east at first.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 5 to 6, locally 7 at first, veering west to northwest 3 to 4 in the early afternoon, then northerly 4 to 5 in the evening, perhaps locally 6 on Monday.

Rather rough, locally rough in the north this morning, decreasing slight this afternoon, increasing moderate to rather rough this evening.

Outbreaks of rain, heavy at times, clearing later.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor in rain.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North to northwest 4 to 6, backing northwest 3 to 4 by afternoon, then southwest 4 in the evening.

Moderate to rather rough, decreasing slight by afternoon, increasing moderate overnight.

Rain on Tuesday.

Good, becoming moderate to poor in rain.

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
