

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Much of England and Wales dry with warm sunny spells developing, although some rain at first over northern Pennines, and occasionally over Northern Ireland. Heavy rain across northwest Scotland, but drier and warmer in eastern Scotland. Overnight rain will clear Scotland and spread southwards to England and Wales as it dies out. Most places becoming dry by dawn. Winds easing.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Most places dry on Thursday although a few showers far north of Scotland. Many areas will see some sunshine with broken cloud in central and southern England. On Friday most places dry and bright although some showers in far north.
