Forecast for Monday 01 Jan 2024

Weather: A dry bright day with patchy mainly high cloud. Best of the sunshine likely to be in the afternoon. Low cloud developing in the evening with strengthening southeast winds.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 80% but 40% in the evening.

Low Cloud and visibility: A few patches of low cloud early morning, but soon lifting. Then more widespread cloud above 600m in the evening. Visibility away from cloud moderate to good, some slight deteriorations in light rain and hill snow showers.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist’s View

Note the deteriorating conditions in the evening with low cloud and strengthening winds.

Forecast for Tuesday 02 Jan 2024

Weather: Dry early hours, then outbreaks of rain and snow spreading from south by morning, the snow falling to 400m at first but tending to rise to 700m. Some heavy outbreaks in the morning with blizzard conditions possible at higher levels but easing later.

Maximum wind: Easterly 40 gusts 55mph, easing 20 gusts 30mph later.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 10%

Low Cloud and visibility: Extensive cloud bases 450-750m with poor visibility under cloud during heavier outbreaks of rain, snow or drizzle.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 1 Celsius rising to Plus 4.
 At 800m: Minus 3 Celsius rising to Zero.
 Freezing level: 400m rising to 800-900m but some uncertainty.
